Full Boarding

Throughout the school, international pupils benefit greatly from our modern approach to boarding education and fit in quickly to our community of 90 regular boarders.

There are no compulsory exeat weekends.

Weekends are split into 'in' weekends, where pupils enjoy a full Saturday of lessons and sport followed by a Sunday of activities, and 'out' weekends, when full boarders will experience an exciting programme of trips and excursions, led by our excellent boarding staff. 
Finding Us
